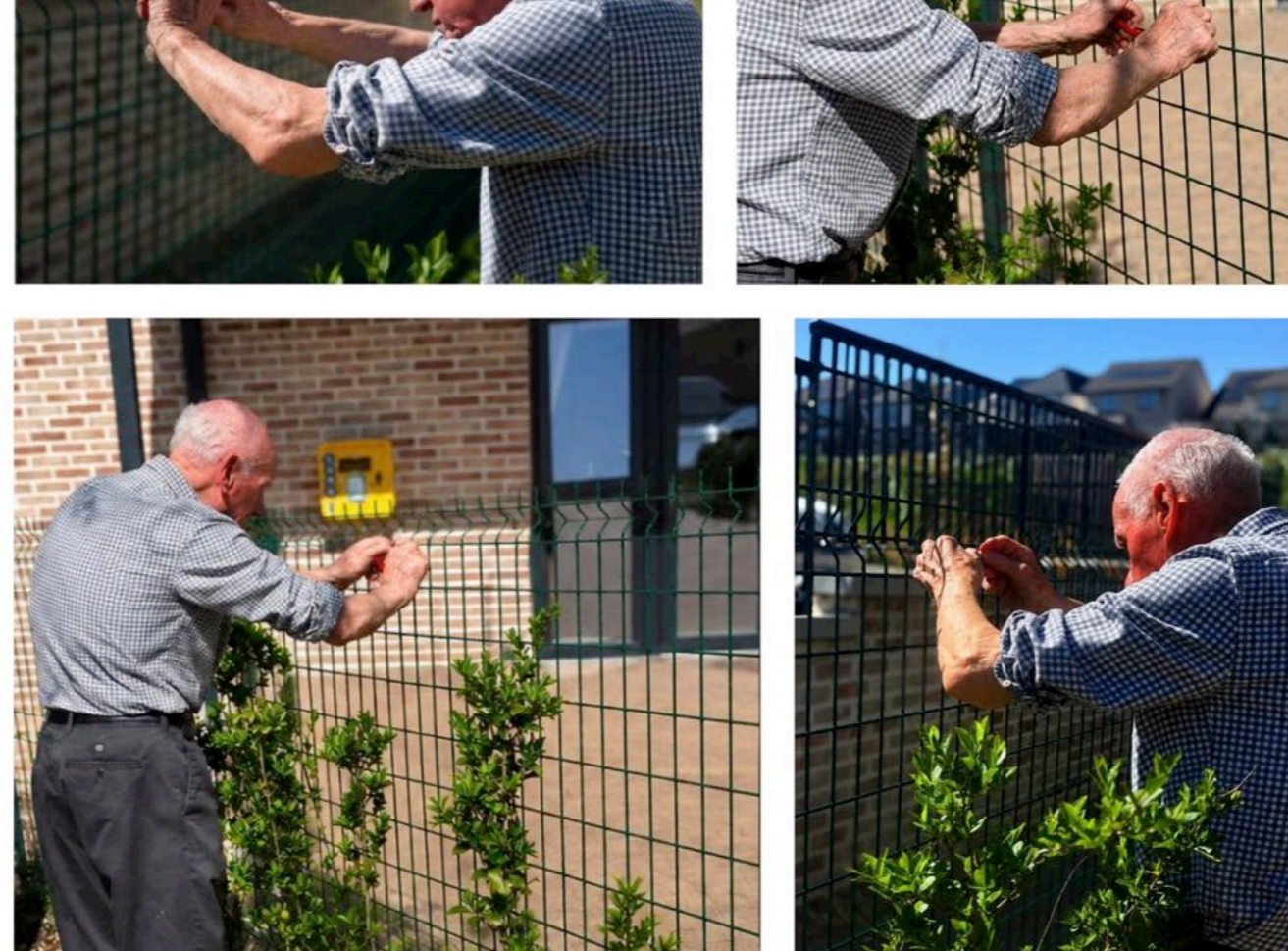
RECENT ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

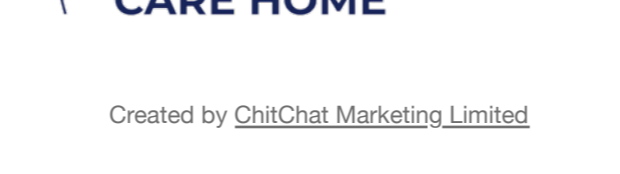
